It is a violation of JDOW's security policy to enter or leave the factory without scanning in or out of the gates with your security badge, or to scan another employee in or out of the factory with your security badge. If you forget your badge or the badge does not work, an employee is required to see the security guard in the front lobby to determine if their badge has been deactivated and/or obtain a temporary badge. A temporary badge will allow the employee to enter and exit the factory at the front lobby only. The temporary badge must be returned when the employee leaves the factory. Remember, any violation of this policy may result in the company issuing discipline.

Requirements:

- ✓ The applicant must be a high school graduate.
- ✓ The applicant must be a dependent child of a UAW Local 74 member in good standing.
- ✓ The applicant must have a 2.5 grade point average if he/she is enrolled in a college or university.
- ✓ The applicant must submit an essay of at least 150 words to this local union. The title and substance of the essay will be: “What have labor unions done for the worker in the last 50 years?”
- ✓ The applicant must be a full time student.
- ✓ Applications must be accompanied with a transcript of grades from your high school or college.
- ✓ Applications must be submitted by ***February 8th, 2017.***
- ✓ Scholarship checks will be presented to the College, University or Vo-Tech school.
