

JDOW Bereavement??? Page 17 Section 2 of the John Deere/UAW Contract Book

A. When death occurs in your immediate family you will be excused for any 5 normal scheduled days of work during the 5 calendar days (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays) immediately following the date of death. Immediate family includes your spouse, son and daughter.

B. When death occurs in your family, i.e. grandmother, grandfather, granddaughter, grandson, father, mother, mother-in-law, father-in-law, brother, sister, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, stepchild, stepfather, stepmother, stepsister, and also employee's spouse's brother, sister, and grandparents, an employee will be excused for any 3 normal scheduled days of work during the 3 calendar days (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays) immediately following the date of death.

This does not include your spouse's brother-in-law or sister-in-law.
