At The Beach Ottumwa and Sycamore park by the Beach

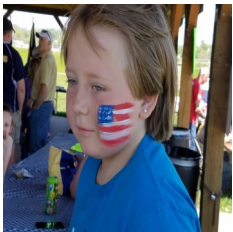
This year we will be having a **Cruise-in Car, Bike and Tractor Show**.

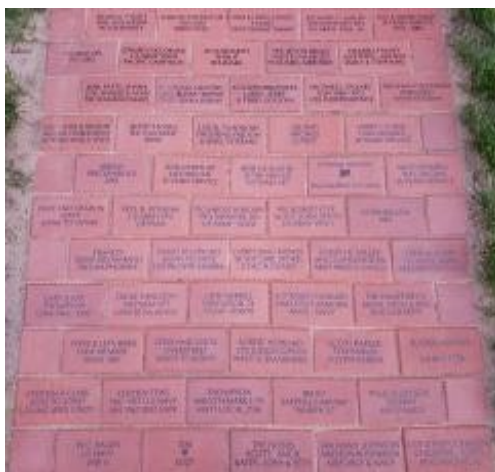
Kids Movie Night
